87,000 Tourists Visit Japan in '54

TOKYO.—More than 87,000 foreign tourists visited Japan in 1954, spending \$38,500,000, the Transportation Ministry has announced. As compared with 1953 the number increased by 15.4 per cent and the money spent by 16.7 per cent. Americans topped the list of visitors with 50.1 per cent followed by Chinese, Britons, Filipinos and Koreans.
