I finally found time to answer your last letter. I'm sorry I haven't answered sooner but I've been too busy.

I arrived here in Denver on July 4th for a 10 week course for Flight Engineers. I don't know how I'm going to like it yet. I won't start for a week I guess. I'll tell you more about it after I get started.

So far the place looks pretty good. I haven't had much time to look around yet because they have had me busy taking a 64 and a clothing check. I suppose I'll pull a little K.P. and detail too before I start school.

What are you doing now Lew? Have you finished in Balkhast yet. I hear that Beault and Beaman, Mills and that bunch are in Lincoln Neb. They seem to think that they are going to China. That's probably where I'll go too. How about you? Have you any idea what you will be doing?

Dolous and little Pat are back in California now. I managed to get seen
