Auto Crashes Into Hotel

Hits 2nd Car, Veers
Across Third St.

An unwelcome intruder barged into the Rex Hotel at 236 Third Street yesterday, but in this it was an automobile.

The car, driven by Stanley Hackett, 43, a contractor, of 521 Alicia Way, Los Altos, struck another machine at Third and Tehama Streets, then veered across Third and through the hotel doors.

The doors and a staircase were broken. The auto blocked the entrance until towed away.

Hackett's car was pulling out of Tehama when it collided with one driven by Alfred Jenkins, 37, of 359 Green Street, traveling south on Third Street.

Hackett was treated at Harbor Emergency Hospital for cuts and bruises and cited for failure to yield the right of way.
