

# 10 AT U. C. WIN HONOR PRIZES

Ten University of California students from the Bay area have been awarded prizes for creative or scholarly excellence during the 1954-55 academic year, UC officials announced yesterday.

The ten are among twenty-nine recipients for the year. The winners and their prizes:

Paul Fong, University Medalist for the Class of 1955, of 1555 Jackson Street, \$100 Dorothea Klumpke Roberta Prize in mathematics (to be shared equally with another winner).

William A. Atkinson, 45, Avon Road, Berkeley, \$100 Johnson Award in Forestry and \$150 Final Award of the same prize; Albert E.
