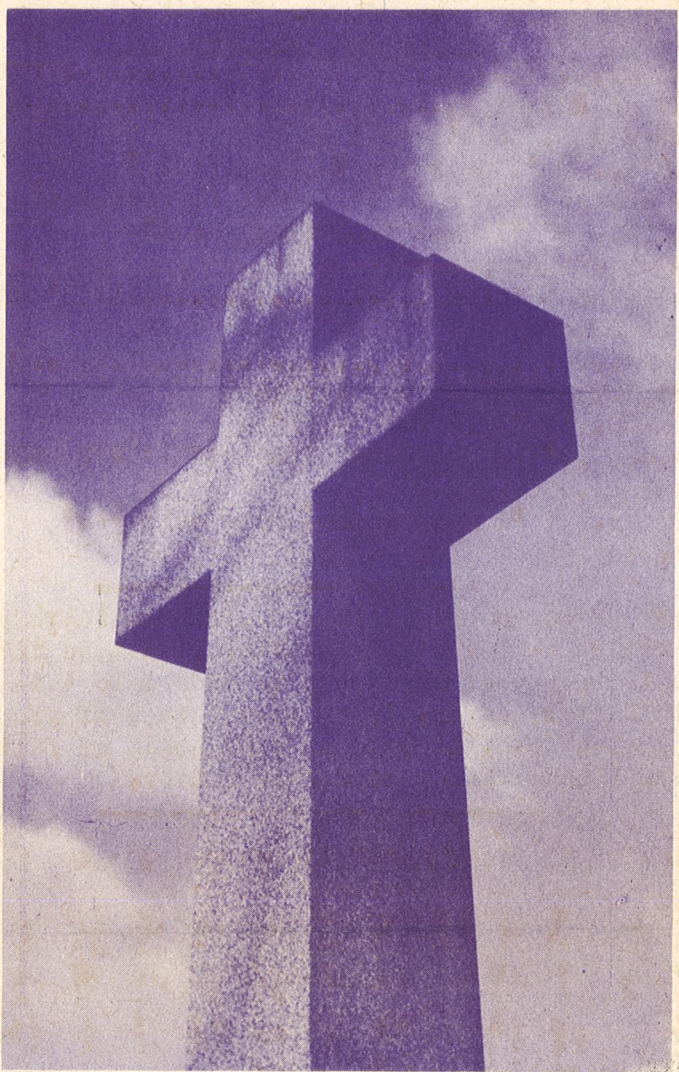

GENERALISSIMO CHIANG'S MORAL LAW -

These rules, by Generalissimo Chiang Kai Shek, for Chinese soldiers are printed on a little card and distributed under the auspices of the Officers' Moral Endeavor Association:

1. Thou shalt not covet riches.
2. Thou shalt not fear to die.
3. Thou shalt not advertise thyself for vain glory
4. Thou shalt not be proud.
5. Thou shalt not commit adultery nor gamble.
6. Thou shalt not be lazy.
7. Thou shalt not smoke.
8. Thou shalt not drink wine.
9. Thou shalt not borrow money.
10. Thou shalt not lie.
