

GENERALISSIMO CHIANG'S MORAL LAW -

- 2. Thou shalt not fear to die.
- 3. Thou shalt not advertise thyself for vain glory
- 4. Thou shalt not be proud.
- 5. Thou shalt not commit adultery nor gamble.
- 6. Thou shalt not be lazy.
- 7. Thou shalt not smoke.
- 8. Thou shalt not drink wine.
- 9. Thou shalt not borrow money.
- 10. Thou shalt not lie.
