

New Electric Brain Feat

REDONDO BEACH (Calif), Nov. 8.—(AP)—An electronic brain flashed coast-to-coast answers to mathematical problems almost as fast as they were fed into it from a keyboard 3,000 miles away yesterday.

Logistics Research, Inc., here, manufacturer of the Computer, said spectators at the Eastern Joint Computer Conference in Boston sent it mortgage, arithmetic and trigonometry problems and got answers almost instantly by teletype.

The company suggested that through such a system a company's branch-office clerk could have instant access to vital records thousands of miles away at a main office. Or two or more Computers could exchange information or control one another regardless of location.
