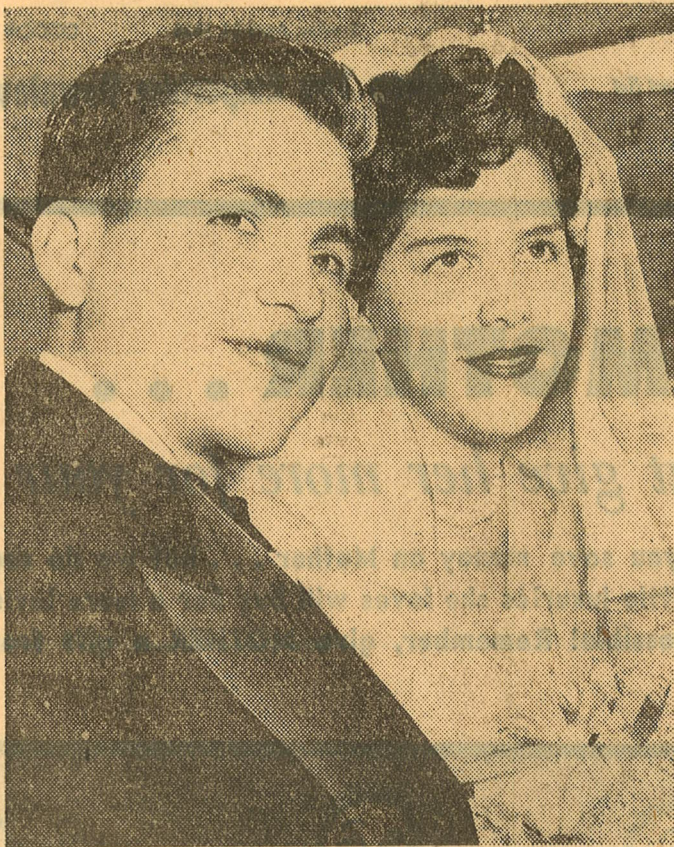


14 YEAR OLD S.F. GIRL WED
