The ceremonies and dancing -from 11:30 a. m. to 2:30 p. m. -were arranged by the Maiden the first day of a supervisors'


Other new fixtures in the lane include benches for the weary of foot, sidewalk tables and ton and Kearny Streets-will chairs and blooming plants and
