PUPPY CALLED COLIC CURE

MUNDFORD (England).—An eighteenth century medical book, giving cures for rheumatism, backache, baldness, listlessness and colic, has been found here.

Rheumatism, the book said, can be cured by applying warm treacle (molasses) to the affected limb. Backache is relieved if garlic or hog's lard is rubbed on the foot, the book asserted.

Baldness can be overcome by rubbing the head with onions "until red," followed by an application of honey, claimed the book. That listless feeling will vanish by sniffing strong vinegar. The book advised colic sufferers to "hold a live puppy to the stomach constantly."
