San Mateo's San Carlos Link Of Freeway Opens Today

Automobiles will begin moving for the first time today over the newest section in the ever-growing Bayshore Freeway — five miles between Sixteenth Avenue in San Mateo to San Carlos.

B. W. Booker, assistant State highway engineer, said the six lane project built at a cost of \$5,859,778 will provide a total length of 16.4 miles of continuous freeway.

Cautioning motorists that some aspects of construction still remain to be completed, Booker said the new section, however, will permit motorists to travel northbound over the new lanes while four interchanges along the route are placed in limited use.

Interchanges are at Nineteenth Avenue and Hillsdale Boulevard in San Mateo, Ralston Avenue in Belmont, and Holly Street in San Carlos.

While the remaining work is continuing, Booker said, drivers should exercise care in driving over the section.

The transition period will require several hours tomorrow, Booker said. Temporary signs to guide traffic have been erected. However, he added, motorists approaching the new freeway project from the south should reduce speed in the construction zone.

It will require about two more months to complete the entire project.
