

Golden Gate Exposition's 15th Anniversary Fete Set

The fifteenth anniversary of the Golden Gate International Exposition of 1940 will be celebrated with open house receptions, pilgrimages and special events at Treasure Island next week.

The opening ceremonies will be held at 12:15 p. m. May 19, when officers of the great World's Fair of 1940 will make

their time honored pilgrimage to Treasure Island exposition landmarks.

First, there will be a reception at the Officers Club Annex on the old "Magic Carpet" north of the Administration Building, then the Quindecennial Luncheon and a motorcade through "Memory Lane."

The Navy, which took over the island after the fair, will hold open house May 21, Armed Forces Day, and on May 22. The
