

CHURCH MEET BY CHINESE

The first national conference of Chinese churches in the United States will open today at the First Chinese Baptist Church, 1 Waverly Place, and the Chinese Presbyterian Church, 925 Stockton Street.

The four day conference, sponsored by the National Council of Churches, will be opened with addresses by Dr. John A. Gardner, director of the San Francisco Council of Churches, Consul General T. K. Chang, S. H. Gee, chairman of the Chinese Six Companies, and Robert S. Lee, president of the Chinese Chamber of Commerce.

Among the principal topics of discussion will be: "Changing Chinese in a Changing Community"; "The Chinese Church—Literature and Language"; "Evangelism Among the Chinese"; and, "The Chinese and Religious Leadership."
