Two powerful San Francisco Chinese organizations repledged their faith in the United Nations, reaffirmed their support of the Nationalist Government of the Republic of China and again renounced the Chinese Communist regime yesterday.

A formal statement published by the Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association (formerly the Six Companies) and the Chinese Anti-Communist League on behalf of "the Chinese in the United States" declared:

"We are convinced that the China question holds the key to the peace and security of Asia. The turmoil and the threat of war in Asia today are the direct result of the Communist conquest of China. "Until Communism is uprooted from Chinese soil and human freedom and decency restored to the millions of Chinese, there can be no genuine peace and security in Asia and the world.

"In the face of the world crisis we solemnly re-declare that we recognize and support only the National Government of the Republic of China. It is this Government that represented China as one of the founding powers of the United Nations ...

"We are also resolutely opposed to recognition of that regime by any member state of the United Nations, and to seating it in the United Nations. Such acts would be a contravention of the principles laid down in the United Nations Charter."
