

Chicken Displays Family Traits

MUNDHAM (England). — A 10 month old fowl descended from Duplicate, a hen that created a world record by laying 462 eggs in twelve months, is following in the family tradition.

The bird, belonging to a farmer, George Hutchings, produced three eggs in one day—a rare event. An even rarer event was Duplicate's record when she laid ten eggs in twenty-four hours. Duplicate died last year of a burst blood vessel. Like her, the young hen is a battery housed bird.
