Jet Twice Flies Over U.S. in 8 Hours

SEATTLE, Oct. 16.—(AP)— The Boeing 707, America's first commercial jet transport plane,

flew round-trip across the nation t oday in the record time of 8 hours and 6 minutes.

The big plane flew from Seattle to Washington, D.C. in 3 hours and 58 minutes. This

cpilled more than one-third off the conventonal airliner mark.

After a brief stopover at Washington, the 707 set what is believed to be an east-west transcontinental record by taking 4

hours and 8 minutes to fly from Washington back to Seattle. The crafe averaged an an-

nounced 592 miles per hour eastward, and 570 miles per

hour westward.

The 707 winged over the control tower in Seatle at 3:39

p.m. (PST) after leaving Washington at 11:21 a.m. (PST).
