

# Plane Circles North Pole

FAIRBANKS (Alaska), May 12.—(AP)—A Scandinavian Airlines System transport carrying forty European businessmen to an International Chamber of Commerce meeting at Tokyo, landed here on schedule last night after a fourteen hour flight from Bodo, Norway, over the North Pole.

After a one hour layover in which the passengers and eleven crew members were given a reception by the Fairbanks Chamber of Commerce, the plane—the Erik Viking—left at 7:20 p. m., Alaska time, on the seventeen hour flight to Tokyo.

The plane made a 360 degree turn over the pole and dropped a small SAS flag.
