An Electronic Green Light

LYNN (Mass.), July 11.— (AP) — General Electric Co. announced otday development of a new traffic light that automatically counts cars and "rations" the green light to keep traffic moving at maximum efficiency.

Cars approaching a main highway on a secondary road are counted by an electronic controller. Then the signal allows just enough "green time" to clear the autos.

General Electric officials said the electronic device is part of a new line of devices designed to meet street intersection traffic problems and keep traffic moving on main highways.
