

# Doctors' 2 Sons Get Polio

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ELY (Nev.), May 6.—Dr. M. A. Sonderegger, whose two sons came down with polio after he inoculated them with Salk vaccine, said today he has not lost faith in the vaccine.

**“It was just one of those unfortunate things that happen sometimes,”** he said.

The 43-year-old physician gave shots to the boys, John, 2, and Brian, 8, as well as his wife and daughter, using vaccine made by Cutter Laboratories of Berkeley.

Neither the wife nor daughter have become ill, but the boys were stricken within twelve days.

**“My wife and I have had quite a shock, but we haven't lost faith in the vaccine,”** Doctor Sonderegger said.

He plans to continue the series of inoculations in his family. His children are the only polio cases reported among 13,000 Nevada youngsters vaccinated.

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
