

Firemen Walk Into Blaze

VERNON, March 29.—(INS) —Several firemen, wearing a new kind of fire suit developed in Germany and designed to withstand extreme temperatures, walked into the center of a 3,000 degree blaze yesterday and emerged unscathed.

The suit is made of flame resistant cotton topped with aluminum powder and covered on the outside with a layer of aluminum foil.

Frank D. Rosenthal, sales manager for a New York firm handling distribution of the suits, explained that 95 per cent of the heat from a fire is turned away by the aluminum foil. He said the temperature inside the suit gets no higher than 100 degrees.
