

# Population in Bay Region Growing 11,200 a Month

Population in the nine-county Bay area increased on an average of 11,200 persons a month during 1954, the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce reported yesterday.

A study of estimates just released in the 1955 sales management survey of buying power indicated that the total Bay area population now stands at 3,150,200.

Ralph Koeber, manager of the chamber's research department, said the San Francisco total, as of January 1, was 808,000.

The State as a whole continued its population growth at the rate of 54,775 persons a month during 1954.
