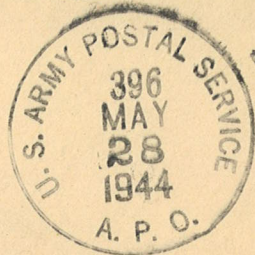


I can't tell you what we are doing but when we are finished here there is always a chance that we will join you again.
