

# Shock Kills Girl In Dental Chair

BAKERSFIELD, May 11.—

(AP)—Coroner Stanley Neuman reported today the death of an 11 year old girl in a local dentist's office Monday apparently was due to novocain sensitivity and shock.

The girl, Helen Valarie Mutz, died after receiving a local anesthetic in preparation for dental work.

Neuman said laboratory tests of the drug used proved it was of the same quality as that generally used in dental work.
