WASHINGTON, May 7.(AP) -The Census Bureau said today the population of the United States increased by about $25,000,000$ in the ten years since Victory Day in Europe, May 8, 1945.

In May, 1945, the population, including the Armed Forces overseas was nearing the 140 , 000,000 mark.

The Bureau estimated that on May 8 this year the figure will be $164,865,000$ and that by the end of the month it will go over the $165,000,000$ mark.
