25 MILLION GAIN DURING 10 YEARS

WASHINGTON, May 7. — (AP)—The Census Bureau said today the population of the United States increased by about 25,000,000 in the ten years since Victory Day in Europe, May 8, 1945.

In May, 1945, the population, including the Armed Forces overseas was nearing the 140,• 000,000 mark.

The Bureau estimated that on May 8 this year the figure will be 164,865,000 and that by the end of the month it will go over the 165,000,000 mark.
