

Solid Red Apple Is Purely Esthetic

TSURUTA (Japan).—Kenzo Maeda, 74, has harvested fifty apples red, red to the core. The crop of one hybrid tree climaxed years of experiment.

He said his orchard within a few years would produce in commercial quantities. Maeda predicted "great popular demand" for the new variety, based on "pure esthetic appeal." The apples taste just like the ordinary varieties.
