

# Use of Nuclear Electricity Is Seen

LOS ANGELES, June 8.—(INS)—A public utility president predicts that by 1970 1½ per cent of the electric power used in the United States will be produced by nuclear powered plants.

Henry B. Sargent, president of the Arizona Public Service Company, said, however, that this will not mean cheaper electricity.

Speaking before the National Industrial Association convention, Sargent explained that the price will stay up because "the type of fuel accounts for only 17 per cent of the total cost of producing electricity."
