

# Grants Spur Start of New Stanford Medical Center

Construction is expected to start on the first building in Stanford University's new medical center—an \$800,000 rehabilitation unit—within the next year.

The move was announced yesterday after receipt of a grant of \$434,892 from the State Advisory Hospital Council. Federal and university funds will be combined to provide an equal amount.

Stanford spokesmen said there also is a possibility of obtaining an additional \$50,000 from the State of Nevada, a sum which would likewise be matched by the State and university.

The rehabilitation unit will have approximately forty thousand square feet of floor space. Speech, hearing, child psychology, counseling and testing facilities now housed in various buildings on the campus will be combined with medical units now located at the Stanford Medical School in San Francisco.

The university plans an eventual transfer of the entire medical school to the campus.
