NEWBURYPORT (M a s s.)—Charles Lightbody, 30, a bridegroom who allegedly beat his wife four days after their September 12 marriage, was ordered in district court to remain away from her for two months. Judge Norman Espovich continued for that period the case of Lightbody, now living in Haverhill, charged with assault and battery on his bride, Harriet, 24.

Mrs. Lightbody said he struck her, broke her eyeglasses, took back the wedding ring and tore up the marriage certificate after she declined to go out with him because she felt they should save money. Lightbody said there was no fight.
