

12 Held as Members of Teenage Sex Thrill Club

DECATUR (Ga.), June 28.—(AP)—Teen-age sex parties, some of which lasted a week and left one 15 year* old girl pregnant, are under investigation in Decatur, Dekalb County Police Chief Ernest Sikes said today.

Sikes said twelve youths, six girls and six boys, were tied directly to a "non-virgin club" of teen-agers.

George Heist, Dekalb County investigator, said the club involved a number of other boys and girls who were not directly

linked to the group by available evidence.

Heist said the twelve directly involved were members of prominent families. The girls range from 14 to 16 and the boys from 14 to 19 years old.

The youths and their parents

were called before juvenile authorities and given warnings. With the exception of a 19 year old boy who was convicted of "thrill" burglaries and auto theft, the club members were turned over to juvenile authorities.
