VANCOUVER (B. C.).—(AP)
—After seventeen years of marching after the cows instead of marching down the aisle, 40 year old Dorothy Pentland says she is tired of waiting for the farmer to say "I do."

She is suing Benjamin Crowe, 64 year old farmer, for breach of promise and asking for a half interest in his farm. She complained in court that she had been a housekeeper as well as a milkmaid without pay and "he stayed in bed while I went for the cows—at 4:30 a. m. each day."

It has, she said, been a long wait. She said Crowe promised to marry her in 1937.
