Mathematics Meet Due

New developments in the field of higher mathematics will be presented at Stanford University tomorrow when experts from seven western States open a meeting of the American Mathematical Society.

Some eighty members are ex-

pected for the sessions, which will include a talk by Prof. Irving Kaplansky of the University of Chicago, who will speak on operator algebras, a branch of higher mathematics.

Ten minute papers on other new developments will be read by several other members. The delegates will be guests at a reception at 4 p. m. in Bowman Alumni House.
